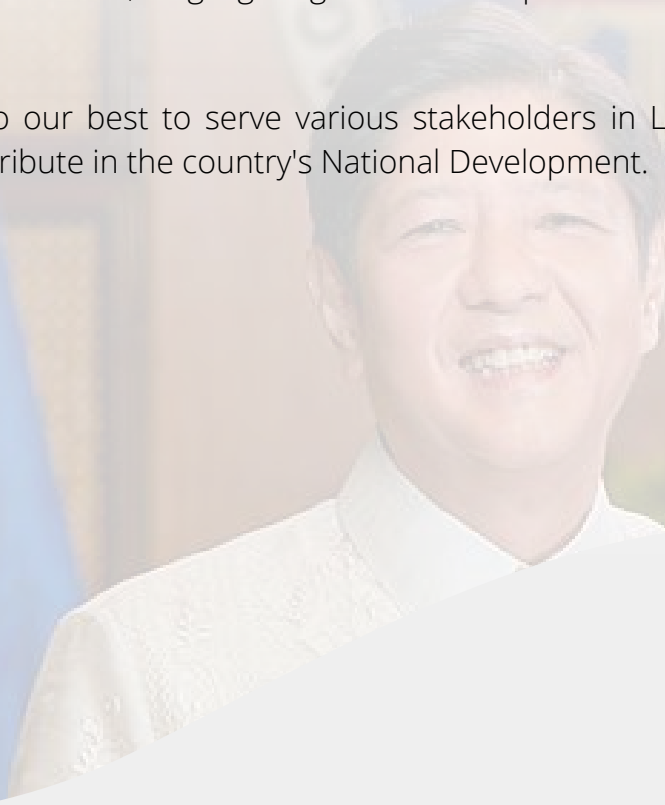

# EXECUTIVE SUMMARY

## QUALITY ASSURANCE

01

DMMMSU, a higher education institution, has achieved significant milestones in quality assurance and recognition. In November 2021, the University successfully passed its first surveillance visit for the Quality Management System, demonstrating its commitment and hard work. The following year, DMMMSU passed the second surveillance audit, ensuring the maintenance of its ISO certification.

Additionally, DMMMSU received recognition from the Civil Service Commission-Region 1 Office (CSC RO1) for meeting the standards for Maturity Level 2 indicators in the Rewards and Recognition System. The University also completed the requirements for Recruitment, Selection, and Placement; Learning and Development; and Performance Management, earning competencies in these areas. Furthermore, DMMMSU underwent an onsite assessment leading to the Bronze Award.

Moreover, the University obtained certification for passing the Institutional Sustainability Assessment (ISA) for one of its campuses. The assessment evaluated key result areas such as governance and management, quality of

teaching and learning, professional exposure, research, and creative work, support for students, and relations with the community. Most of the indicators in these areas received a rating of 3, indicating good practice.

Furthermore, DMMMSU also received three stars from the QS Intelligence Unit that conducted a rigorous and independent data collection and analysis of performance metrics as set out in the QS Stars methodology.

Finally, DMMMSU has made an outstanding debut in the prestigious World University with Real Impact (WURI) Ranking! With its first year of participation, DMMMSU secured 42nd place in the Fourth Industrial Revolution category. Also, DMMMSU has been named one of the Top 300 Global Innovative Universities.

## INSTRUCTION

DMMMSU houses 5 Centers of Development, 2 Provincial Institutes, and 2 TESDA Recognized Assessment Centers. Also, it boasts 20 Level IV Accredited Academic Programs.

DMMMSU's commitment to quality programs and processes has resulted in consistently high ratings in licensure examinations, surpassing national passing rates. The top three performing programs in the previous year were BS Agriculture (NLUC), BS Criminology Program of MLUC, and Bachelor of Secondary Education of SLUC. These programs achieved passing rates of 74.07%, 64.71%, and 83.33% respectively, exceeding the national passing rates for first-time takers.

Furthermore, DMMMSU graduates are highly sought after by the industry and demonstrate exceptional performance in licensure examinations. Notably, Stephanie Jan T. Mayrena was the top 7 in the November 2022 Nurse Licensure Examination, while Eugene D. Ballesteros earned the Top 4 spot, in the November 2022 Agriculturist Licensure Examination. Also, Marvin E. Perez was Top 7 in the March 2023 Licensure Examination for Teachers. These achievements reflect the caliber of graduates produced by DMMMSU and their excellence in their respective fields.

Also in 2022, DMMMSU achieved a commendable milestone by promoting 244 faculty members based on NBC 461 8th Cycle. Among the promoted individuals, ten faculty members were elevated to the position of New Full - fledged



Professors. The distinguished professors include Nora A. Oredina, Paulito Nisperos, Floribeth P. Cuison, Angelina T. Gonzales, Nona M. Rivera, Melda M. Uychoco, Maricon C. Viduya, Precilita L. Osillos, Isidro L. Duran, and Eduard M. Albay. This accomplishment reflects the university's commitment to recognizing and rewarding the excellence and expertise of its faculty members.

Additionally, DMMMSU made another historic accomplishment! DMMMSU was the Champion in the 2022 SCUAA 1 which was held at the Pangasinan State University – Lingayen Campus, Pangasinan on November 21-25, 2022. DMMMSU garnered 90 gold, 41 silver, and 66 bronze medals. Meanwhile, DMMMSU was the 2nd Runner Up in PASUC-1 Cultural and Arts Competitions.

## RESEARCH

As for research, DMMMSU allocated 10.9 million pesos for research and extension. Moreover, DMMMSU had 20 research publications. As for paper presentations in local, regional, national, and international conferences, DMMMSU had 144.

Furthermore, research studies by DMMMSU personnel continue to make an impact on the international research community. Last year, DMMMSU recorded 160 citations and 115 intellectual property registrations.

In recognition of the commitment of DMMMSU personnel in helping realize our objectives in research and extension, as well as to encourage more to engage in research and extension activities, incentives for exemplary achievements are being provided.

Two (2) million and 400 hundred pesos was utilized to incentivize IP registrations, research publications, paper presentations, citations, and external funding.

DMMMSU also co-hosted the 2nd International Conference in Information and Computing Research on December 10-11, 2022.

Further, DMMMSU made commendable work in outsourcing funds. As a result, DMMMSU was granted a staggering amount of 35.4 million pesos for both institutional development grant and research and development grant.

## EXTENSION

DMMMSU has also achieved significant accomplishments in its extension activities. The University has successfully implemented 116 extension programs aligned with the mandated and priority programs of the State University and College (SUC). These programs have served 38,916 clients, exceeding the initial target by an impressive 322%.

Furthermore, DMMMSU has established and maintains 85 active partnerships with various stakeholders, including local government units (LGUs), industries, non-governmental organizations (NGOs), national government agencies (NGAs), small and medium enterprises (SMEs), and other relevant entities. These partnerships demonstrate the university's strong connections and collaboration with external organizations, contributing to the effectiveness and impact of its extension activities.

## INFRASTRUCTURE

DMMMSU has made substantial investments in infrastructure projects, with a total expenditure of 269.56 million pesos for completed projects. Additionally, the University currently has ongoing projects with a budget allocation of 368.495 million pesos. These investments reflect DMMMSU's dedication to enhancing its infrastructure and providing a conducive environment for its stakeholders.

Furthermore, the University has received a fund allocation of 142 million pesos for the year 2023, emphasizing its commitment to continuing infrastructure development. These financial commitments and ongoing projects highlight DMMMSU's focus on creating modern and efficient facilities to support its mission of providing quality education and services

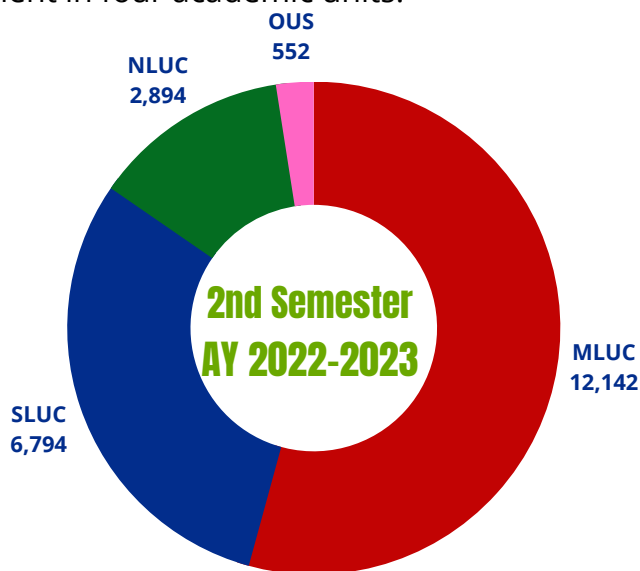

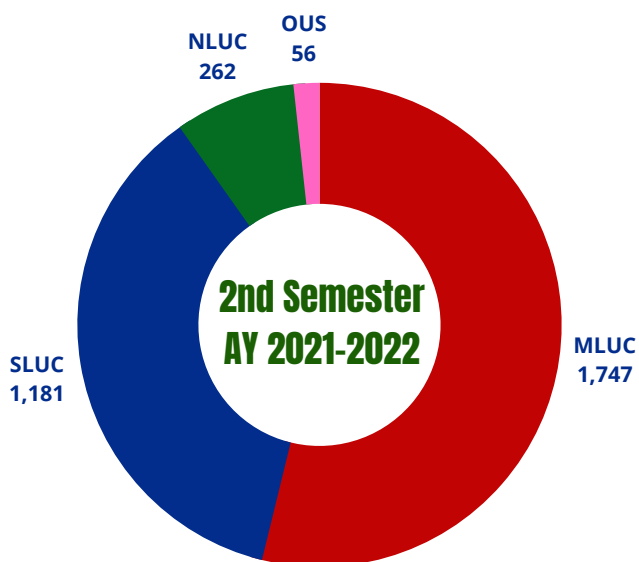

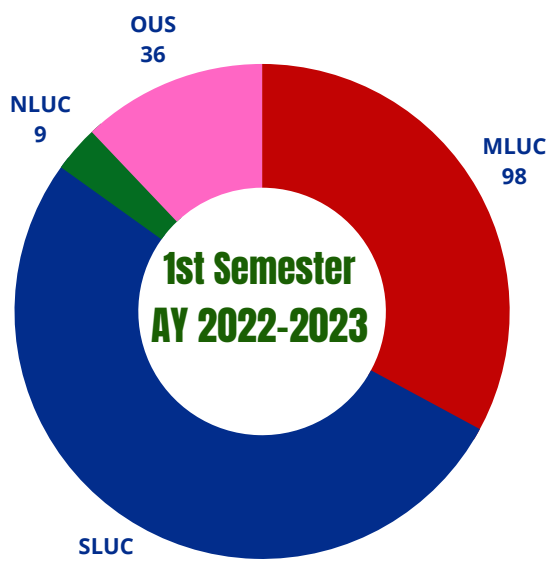
